What should I expect during an assessment?

Initial Screening (optional)

- A focused session to identify key symptoms and determine if a comprehensive assessment is recommended.

Comprehensive Assessment:

- Clinical Interview: A detailed discussion about your history, symptoms, and any difficulties experienced in daily life.
- Standardised Questionnaires: You may be asked to complete self-assessment tools or rating scales to evaluate ADHD symptoms.
- Developmental History: Gathering information about your childhood behaviour, which may involve speaking with family members (optional).
- Additional Evaluations: In some cases, cognitive testing or screening for co-occurring conditions (e.g. anxiety, depression) may be recommended.

Note - Medication is not included as part of this assessment. A diagnosis doesn't automatically mean medication is required and only a psychiatrist or a GP (from 1 February 2026) can prescribe it. If medication is something you wish to explore, we can help by directing you to the right medical professional.

You will receive:

- A clear and accurate ADHD diagnosis, or explanation of what else may be contributing to your symptoms.
- An understanding of how your symptoms affect daily life, including work, study, relationships, routines and personal goals.
- Differentiation between ADHD and other possible conditions, so you receive the right support.
- A comprehensive, personalised report, including practical coping strategies, tailored recommendations, and guidance on next steps, including assistance with referrals to medical professionals if needed.
